## Who Can Join

Families may qualify for *Family Focus* if any of the following apply:

- Combined household income of less than \$40,000 per year
- Receives assistance such as BadgerCare Plus, Medicaid, QUEST, Title 19, or WIC
- A child or caregiver has special needs
- A child is in Head Start
- Licensed foster parent
- A primary caregiver is actively deployed in the military
- A primary caregiver speaks limited English

*Other qualifications may also be considered.*
